

Facebook Group Page “Friends of Walker Lake”

There have been several people that were denied access to our Friends of Walker Lake Facebook Group page because they did not answer the required questions and/or agree to follow the Group rules. Some of those denied access seemed to be family members of those already a member of the page. All questions, including agreeing to follow the group rules, must be answered.

- 1 Be kind and courteous**
We're all in this together to create a welcoming environment. Let's treat everyone with respect. Healthy debates are natural, but kindness is required. Please, no name calling. Postings with political opinions are bound to create tensions and oppositions. This is not the site for that.
- 2 No hate speech or bullying**
Make sure everyone feels safe. Bullying of any kind isn't allowed, and degrading comments about things like race, religion, culture, sexual orientation, gender or identity will not be tolerated. Political opinions do not matter here, so don't post them!
- 3 Official Complaints Don't Belong Here!**
Please contact the office to file an official complaint. If you are having a problem that the state police can handle please get in touch with them on their non-emergency number at (570) 226-5718 or in the case of a true emergency dial 911.
- 4 Must Follow WLLA Rules and Regulations**
Members of Friends of Walker Lake Facebook page agree to follow the Rules and Regulations of Walker Lakeshores Landowners Association, as printed in the RedBook and as amended and revised by the board of directors and/or by community vote in the future.
Posting and/or encouraging on the Facebook page to break or not follow the rules & regulations is automatic removal from the Facebook group. Additionally, breaking of actual rules could be subject to fine, see the rules & regs for more info.

WLLA is serious about these rules, and we have removed just a few people since the page was created for not following the rules, especially Rule #4.

Examples for removal include someone encouraging and others to drive their vehicles on the lake ice. When told that driving on the ice with any type of vehicle is not allowed, the person got more bold saying WLLA had no rights to stop people from doing so

Another example was a person continually encouraged others to hold back their assessment payments and would continually make untrue accusations.
