

The Lake Committee Report. Meeting held September 13, 2021

BEACH TESTING

- Weekly testing for eColi is required by the PA Dept. of Health. Weekly reports are posted on the website and results remain within acceptable levels. Testing has ended for this year as the beaches are currently closed for swimming.

CREEL SURVEY

- We encourage all anglers to complete the creel survey. This helps to determine if and what fish to stock in the future.

DRAIN PIPE WITH UNKNOWN SOURCE

- A report of water discharging into the lake was investigated. The property owner contacted a licensed plumber who reported that the home was piped correctly and the discharge did not originate from the homeowner's house. The committee concluded that it may be natural runoff that has been diverted closer to the lake.

INVASIVE PLANTS

- Purple Loosestrife has been noted on some lakefront properties. Notices will be sent out next year to the property owners so that they understand the importance of removing this plant.

WLLA DAM

- We are awaiting our consultant's study for submittal to the PA DEP.
- During the storm resulting from Hurricane Ida, the water level at the dam was approximately 0.5 feet above the spillway. We received almost 6" of rain. The dam was monitored as per our Emergency Action Plan (EAP) and no issues or concerns were reported.
