

Lake Committee Report. Meeting April 7, 2026

2025 LAKE REPORTS

The committee met with Aqua Link on April 7 and discussed the Canada Geese issue. Walker Lake currently has a permit

from the US Fish & Wildlife Service to addle eggs on nests along the edge of the lake. Brian Reynolds has addled eggs on

a nest so far. We also discussed scaring the geese and we will do this with noise makers in late June early July. We will

suggest that lakefront property owners do the same and also limit access to geese on their property. Walker Lake has 2

noise guns that create a scare for the geese.

The committee also met with Princeton Hydro & a hydrogeologist to discuss analyzing the possible impact of the

recent Shohola well ordinance setback change on the water quality of Walker Lake.

Aqua Link will be conducting the macrophyte survey & first aquatic plant treatment on May 28.

The committee provided an article in the next newsletter regarding information on the invasive Chinese snails.

In order to continue to keep Walker Lake healthy, we remind all residents to keep pets off of the beaches and to have their septic systems pumped and inspected regularly.
