

Walker Lake Lake Committee report

Walker Lake Dam – The dam inspection took place on August 20 with Koberlein & Kiley Associates. A video camera filmed the pipe under the dam. There was no inspection of the part under the water. Kiley is recommending a local dive team do an underwater inspection this fall. The corrugated metal pipe is corroding in spots and needs to be replaced. Kiley has provided the following recommendations:

1. Slip-lining with a smooth-lined plastic pipe (SLPP);
2. Spray-applied cementitious lining;
3. Cured in-place pipe (CIPP) lining.

I have provided Kiley's report.

There will be a public meeting with Kiley Associates to discuss lake draw down on Saturday, October 26 at 10 am the clubhouse.
