

The Lake Committee Report. Meeting held July 12, 2021

#### *LAKE MONITORING*

- **ACTION ITEM:** The Committee recommends to the board that we do not have Aqua Link spray for water lilies this year as a lesser amount than usual have been observed.

#### *GEESE*

- We've had no reports of geese from landowners. Bill and Scott continue to monitor. Since the goslings have started flying they will now agitate the geese that they observe according to PA guidelines. We **strongly** encourage residents to avoid the nice manicured lawn of the suburbs as this encourages geese to poop on the grass.

#### *BEACH TESTING*

- Weekly testing is required by the PA Dept. of Health. We received notification that West Shore Beach had a high E. coli count resulting in the beach closure. This notice was posted at the beach, the Friends of Walker Lake Facebook page, and the official Walker Lake page as well as an email blast being sent out to everyone.
- We had the beach retested and will submit those results once received to the PA Health Dept. They will then inform us when we may reopen West Shore Beach.
- Clubhouse beach remains open at this time.

#### *CREEL SURVEY*

- We encourage all anglers to complete the creel survey. This helps to determine if we need to stock fish in the future.
