This comes out to about 336 ton of material at a cost of about \$4,750 or less
- 3. Recommend that Warner Paving and Excavating be awarded a contract in the amount of \$2,265 to clean and improve the ditch line of Birch (left side heading from Walker Lake Road) from Cree to Pawnee and a small portion of Pawnee.
