The Association shall indemnify and hold harmless each Officer and Director against any and all liability to others on account of such contract or commitment. This responsibility of the Association will be supported by adequate insurance coverage. Proposed: ARTICLE IX (INDEMNIFICATION) Proposed to be Article IX (Indemnification) because indemnification is available for committee members and other official volunteers, not just Officers and Directors – which effects the numbering of the current Article IX (Amendments). Amendments would become Article X.
Indemnification is available in accordance with Pennsylvania Non-Profit Corporation Code 15Pa.C.S.A. 5741 Subchapter D.
