

**WLLA Road Committee Report
January 20, 2024**

Two Actionable Items

Winter Operations

Winter Material

- Motion to order a truckload of ClearLane Salt at a cost of \$3,100 or less from Pava Salt & Stone.
- Motion to order two loads of anti-skid as needed from D & S Trucking at a total cost of \$1,100 or less.

Snow Contract

- John Duggan and Michael DeVita met with John from Frenchmen Excavating to critique and discuss improvements surrounding the 12' inch snowstorm of January 8th and 9th.
- Improvement was observed during the 3 -4-inch storm of January 16th.

Gravel Roads

- Frenchmen completed the gravel road repairs and created a small area of new ditch line on Seneca off Birch under the awarded contract.
- A subsequent heavy storm eroded a small piece of Cahoonzie off Maple. Frenchmen Excavating said he will repair that small piece at no cost.
- Cahoonzie between Birch and Lakeshore is having additional problems with the ditches which may be beyond just the cleaning by residents. WLLA may have to improve these ditch lines to better handle the heavy flow of water coming down from the upper portion of Cahoonzie. This will be discussed at the upcoming road committee meeting.

Asphalt Roads

- We are starting to get some pothole formation on the asphalt roads. Expecting more when it warms up now after this current freeze.

Road Budget 2024

- The regular Road Committee will be meeting in February to start mapping out a tentative plan for road repairs and some drainage improvements this Spring.
